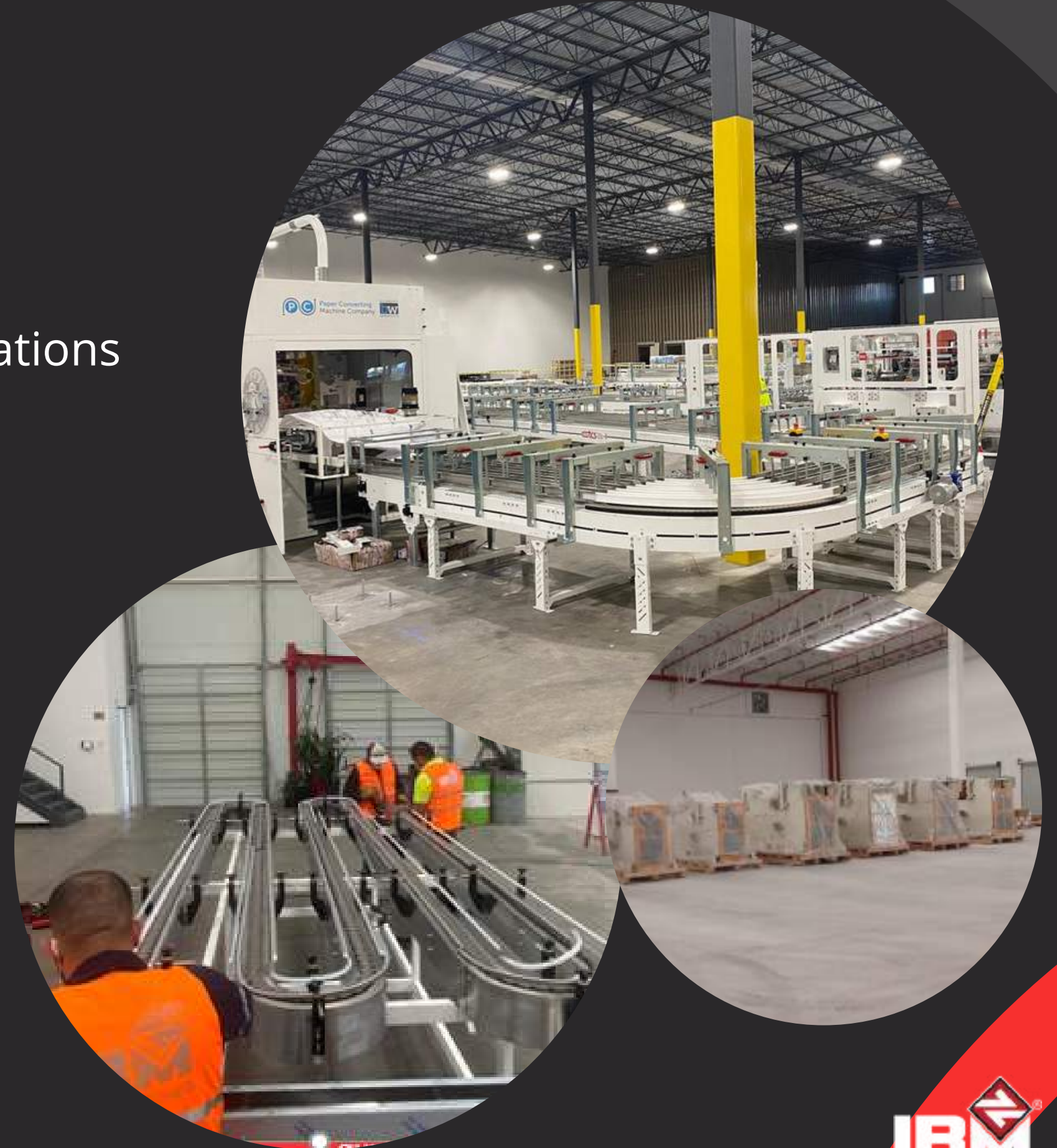

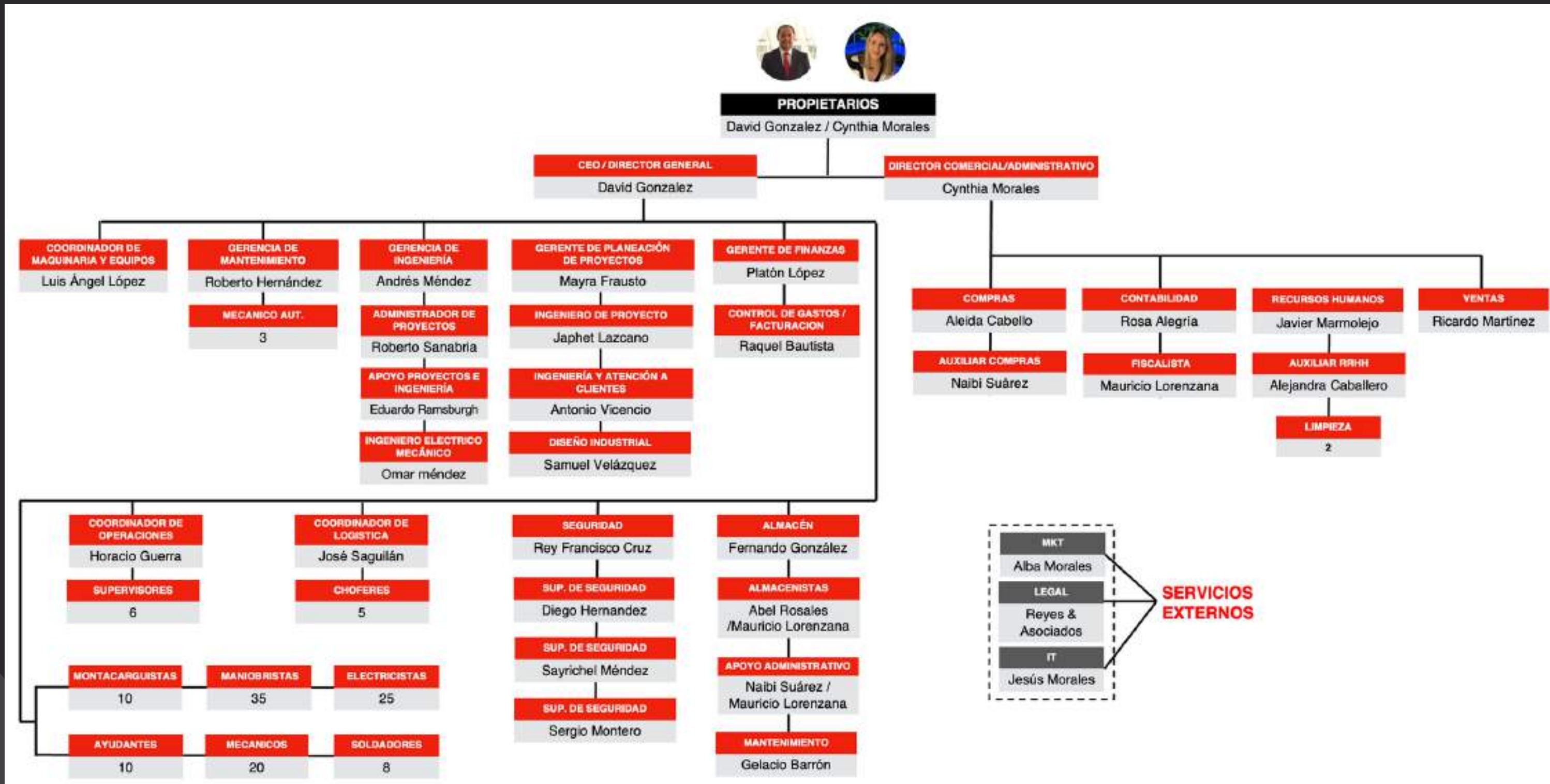

SPECIALIZED LIFTING 50

As the industry adjusts to the Covid-landscape, the **ACT** **SPECIALIZED LIFTING 50** has evolved right alongside it. **Hannah Sundermeyer** reports.



Overcome and adapt

By now it's safe to say ACT readers have seen countless headlines, articles, tweets, and posts about Covid-19, and the evolution of the world as we once knew it. Unfortunately, the specialized lifting industry has not escaped the ongoing challenges as a result of a global pandemic. Yet, as evident in the data and graphs below, the industry has somehow

remained resilient and managed to flourish in certain areas. While employee numbers saw a noticeable drop, the number of gantries, strand jack units and other specialized lifting equipment continues to grow. Let's get into the specifics: 533 gantries and rubber-tired gantries are owned by these companies as compared to 542 in 2020. 1,310 strand jack units are owned by the **SPECIALIZED LIFTING 50**, as compared to 900 in 2020. 5,479 pieces of other specialized lifting equipment (not classified as a gantry or strand jack) are owned by these companies as compared to 5,143 in 2020. The total capacity of every unit owned by every company on the list equals **1,432,859** tons. The total last year was 1,391,662 tons.

- The companies represented in the **SPECIALIZED LIFTING 50** employ **13,388** people.
